**FORT TICONDEROGA**  
5-7 September 2008

The Regiment, under the command of Lieut-Col Paul O'Shaughnessy will appear at Fort Ti on the weekend of 6-7 September. A strong turnout is expected which includes 14 line regiments, Guards and Dragoons plus 14 or more provincial units including Indians, Royal Engineers and the Royal Irish Artillery. Lieut Col Neil Sorenson, King's Rangers is in command and Major Bezio of the 29th Foot is 2IC. This is a Regimental event and all are required to attend.

Time is allowed through the weekend to tour the fort and grounds - you are urged to take advantage. No arms are allowed inside the Museum buildings. No firing or alarms within the fort without orders. 18th Century discipline and dress will be maintained throughout the weekend. No vehicles near camp except for setup, breakdown, and emergencies.

Enter through the back gate and exit through the front gate. Sign-in tent is located just outside the back gate. When you arrive at sign-in, pull over and park. The volunteers on duty will look you up in your unit's member list. If they find you there, you will be given a pass for the weekend. Drivers may sign in for everyone in their car, providing they know their names and what unit they belong to. The sign-in form is on the next page. **Drivers can save time by filling the form out in advance and turning it in when they arrive at the sign-in tent; see next page.** Unload your gear in camp and come around again to park in the big field along the back road. Quartermasters will be located on the access road on the lefthand side of the road.

Uniform shall be No 2 Dress. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Many quality suttlers will be on site,.

Travel is by private vehicle. Recommended route to Ticonderoga from eastern Massachusetts: Take Route 3 or I-93 North into New Hampshire. Just south of Concord NH, take I-89 North. At White River Junction VT, take Route 4 West across Vermont through Rutland to Whitehall NY. Turn right (north) onto NY Route 22. Proceed approximately 26 miles to Ticonderoga. Turn right at Route 74 East. Fort Entrance is on the right.

Thursday, 4 September: 0900 - 1700 hrs

Friday, 5 September: 0900 - 2300 hrs

On Saturday, 6 September, Sign-in will move to the Fort's marquee on Sutler Row. You will be able to sign-in there from 0900 to 1200 hrs. **Anyone arriving after that must report to the Adjutant-General's tent.**
