The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieut-Col Robert Falotico for the **Battle Road Muster** scheduled for Saturday 23 March 2019. This event will serve as our “Shakedown march” for the year, our last chance to inspect uniforms and kit for final corrections before the Lexington Green rehearsal. Note that the Park Service considers this as “required” for all those wishing to appear in park events over Patriot’s Day weekend, and thus also is required for members of the 10th.

Location is the MMNHP Visitor Center on route 2A in Lincoln, MA. Travel is by private vehicle. Car-pooling is recommended. Parking will be in the visitor center lot.

Dress shall be No. 2 for all ranks (Officers may wear shoes and gaiters in lieu of boots). All firelocks are to be equipped with woods, flash guards and hammerstalls. There will be no firing, but National Parks representatives will be inspecting all troops for proper equipment.

- 10:15 hrs** Auditorium - Battle Road Guides and Civilian Evacuees briefing and inspection.
- 10:15 hrs** Muster Field - Inspection of Crown Forces.
- 11:00 hrs** Battle Road Trail - Rehearsal (non-firing) of the civilian evacuees and tactical scenario.
- 12:00 hrs** Lunch (BYO).
- 13:00 hrs** Auditorium - Evacuation of Civilians
