FORT at NO. 4

29 - 30 SEPTEMBER

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico for the *Return to Number 4: Revolutionary War Encampment Weekend*, Fort at No. 4 in Charlestown, New Hampshire, on Saturday 29 September through Sunday 30 September.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring both caps and hats. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The fort's address is: *267 Springfield Road (NH Route 11), Charlestown, NH*. Directions are attached (page 3).

Friday

10:00 hrs – 20:00 hrs: Camp is open for arrivals. The Crown Forces camp is located behind the fort (enter field to the right of the visitor center). Please see the Camp QM upon check-in to submit registration form (page 5) and for further instructions.

Saturday

07:30 hrs – 09:30 hrs: Camp is open for arrivals. **Check in at booth.**

08:30 hrs: ALL vehicles must be out of camp.

Sunday

07:30 hrs – 09:00 hrs: Camp is open for day-trippers only. **Check in at booth.**

15:00 hrs: Vehicles may enter camp and members may break-down and depart. All members shall assist with the break-down and packing of the Camp Kitchen before packing their personal equipment.

15:30 hrs: Event closes to the public

Please remove your vehicle to the re-enactor parking areas as soon as is practical. Offsite parking is at Optical Solutions – about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile north along Lover's Lane (See parking map.). All participating units will have ONE (1) DESIGNATED, ONSITE PARKING SPOT. This vehicle must display the unit parking card on the dashboard and be parked in the designated parking area. The police department will be checking all designated participant parking areas. Day-trippers should be prepared to park in the designated off-site parking areas and use unit shuttle for transportation to and from the designated area.



The event is open to the public from 10:00 hrs until 16:30 hrs Saturday, and 10:00 hrs until 15:30 hrs on Sunday (see schedule below). Starting at 18:30 hrs on Saturday evening, there will be a Candlelight Tour of the Encampment. You should count on being available to the public at that time.

Special Note: The Regiment has been given the Hasting's House in the Fort for use as our kitchen and dining hall for the weekend. Thus, we will not need to set-up the kitchen as normal.

Directions to Fort 4, Charlestown, New Hampshire

- For GPS directions, use this address: *267 Springfield Road (Route 11) in Charlestown, NH.*

- From Boston:
 - Travel north on Route I-93.
 - Just south of Concord, NH, take I-89 north. Travel about 35 miles.
 - Take exit 12 onto NH-11 west toward New London/Sunapee. Continue on Route 11 through Sunapee, Newport and Claremont.
 - From Claremont, follow Routes 11 and 12 about 15 miles toward Charlestown, turning right onto NH-11 west (Springfield Road).
 - The Fort entrance will be on the left. Stop at the Registration table.

- From NH or southern ME:
 - Use Route 101 to I-93, then follow the directions above.

- From central Massachusetts and Rhode Island:
 - Travel north to Worcester.
 - Take I-190 north to Route 2 west.
 - Take exit 24B onto Route 140 north, merging with Route 12 north.
 - Continue on Route 12 north through Keene, NH.
 - Continue north on Route 12 to Charlestown, NH, turning left onto NH-11.
 - The Fort entrance will be on the left. Stop at the Registration table.

- Alternate Route:
 - Take Route 2 west to I-91 north.
 - Take exit 7 onto VT-11 east, crossing the Connecticut River into NH.
 - The Fort entrance will be on the right.
