Minutes: Command Staff Teleconference, Sunday 22 March, 2020 as submitted by Cpl. DeRosa and Antar

1. Companies have been maintaining contact with their members through various means of communication. This will continue, as well as exploring more options such as video calling Zoom/Skype/Facetime, etc. On a more specific note, how to use these tools to keep the forward progress of our recruits, for both kit, and training was discussed. Grady, a recruit of the Colonel's Coy, is in need of a coat, Col, O'Shaughnessey, was going to contact a past member to see if she would be willing to let him use her coat.
2. Although much of the early season has been cancelled, there's still plenty to do, and lots of progress to be made. An example is the breeches class where participants are 2/3 of the way through and are working remotely with Henry Cooke to complete them. Now is also the time to continue to make kit repairs, work on sewing projects, and perform maintenance on muskets.
3. Aside from remote communication, small groups should be set up to hold workshops for drill, kit, and any other items that may need to be addressed. Proper precautions to be observed.
