LESLIE'S RETREAT, SALEM, MA

22 February 2025

The Regiment shall form under the Command of Lt. Colonel Michael Graves on Saturday, 22 February to commemorate the 250th anniversary of Leslie's Retreat in the City of Salem, Massachusetts. On February 26, 1775, Lt. Col. Alexander Leslie's effort to confiscate colonial weapons faced non-violent opposition on Salem's North Bridge.

Uniform shall be Modified No 2 Dress... natural wigs, canteens, tall wool leggings. There will be no firing thus flints are to be replaced by woods. Civilians are welcome to attend in 18th Century attire.

Travel is by private vehicle. Parking will be at the Church Street East Lot (reserved and free) across from St. Peter's Church at 24 St. Peter's Street, Salem, MA.

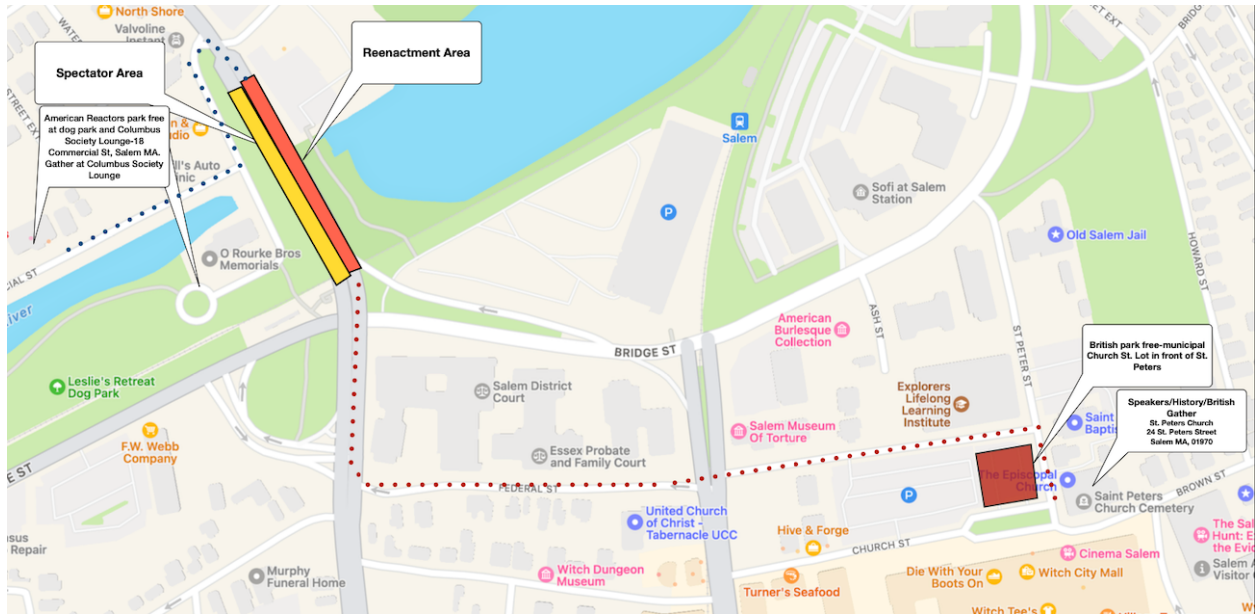
The parade will begin at 09:30 hrs and will end by 11:20 hrs. Box lunches will be provided in the Recreation Hall of the Church to all reenactors after the event. In addition, the Witch House is offering free admissions to reenactors and their family, or a voucher for a future visit. Schedule:

- 09:30 hrs Arrive at Church Street East Lot and stage in the Rec Hall. Public assemble at St. Peter’s Church to hear the speaking portion of the event
- 10:30 hrs Bells toll. Public begin marching towards the bridge. Regiment forms after the public leaves
- 10:50 hrs Regiment begins its march down Federal Street towards North Bridge
- 11:00 hrs The British column is met by local militia on the Bridge. Words are exchanged and the militia follow the British back to the Church Street East Lot
- 11:20 hrs Event ends.
