ST. PATRICK'S / EVACUATION DAY PARADE, BOSTON, MA

15 March 2026

The Regiment shall form under the Command of Lt. Colonel Michael Graves on Sunday, 15 March to parade through South Boston with drums beating, bayonets fixed and Colours flying in commemoration of *Saint Patrick's Day and the 250th Anniversary of Evacuation Day*.

Uniform shall be Modified No 2 Dress... company caps (leather caps for Light Infantry), natural wigs, wool leggings, canteens, and no haversacks. There will be no firing thus flints are to be replaced by woods. In case of cold weather, uniformed soldiers are allowed to wear period-appropriate gloves (check with your CO'Y NCO as to what is acceptable). Civilians, in 18th century attire, are welcome to participate.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged as parking can be tight. Participant drop-off and parking will be at the Gillette Headquarters parking lot at **45 Binford Street, South Boston, MA 02120**. The parking lot is across A Street from the above address. For those who attended previous years, it is where the shuttle dropped us off. The parade is in reverse this year. Road closures in this area will begin by 9:00 AM, so please arrive by 8:30 AM.

After checking in, a shuttle will be available to take participants to our assembly area **541 Dorchester Ave., South Boston, MA**. We are leading the parade this year. See pages 3-5 for complete parade information, including maps.

Begin at Andrew Square, straight up Dorchester Street, right on Telegraph Street, right around Thomas Park, left on G Street, right on 6th Street, left on K Street, right on 4th Street, left on P street, left on East Broadway, bear right to West Broadway, right on A Street (before A Street, 18-wheelers will exit straight down Broadway, exiting the parade),
