FORT ONTARIO
21 – 23 JUNE

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for the *More Wickedness is Coming* encampment weekend at Fort Ontario in Oswego, New York, on Friday 21 June through Sunday 23 June.

Uniform is No. 2 (company uniforms with haversacks, canteens, and short gaiters). Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers may wear shoes with gaiters in lieu of boots. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. Fort Ontario is located at *1 E 4th Street, Oswego, NY*. The most direct way to get there is to follow I-90 Westbound until NY 481 Northbound (exit 34A in NY) and follow 481 until you reach Oswego. It is approximately 340 miles one way from the Lexington Depot. This is a Friday after the school year, so I-90 may be a parking lot. Other routes are available but less direct.

13:00 – 22:00 hrs: Registration open. Arrival and set up camp. The British will be camped on the parade ground within the fort.

07:00 hrs: Reveille

08:00 hrs: Officer and senior NCO meeting

08:30 hrs: NCO call

09:30: Morning Formation, rolls and orders. Guards will be posted throughout the day except for the battles.

10:45 hrs: First Battle

12:00 hrs: Lunch

14:00 hrs: Second Battle. Defend the first attack on the fort

15:30 hrs: Voluntary fashion show for those who wish to attend to show off and explain civilian clothes and/or uniforms

17:00 hrs: Last Guards relieved. Close to public for the day

19:00 hrs: Tavern celebration for Paul Lear's retirement

Sunday

07:00 hrs: Reveille

08:00 hrs: Officer and senior NCO meeting

08:30 hrs: NCO call

10:30: Morning Formation, rolls and orders. Guards will be posted throughout the day except for the battles.

12:00 hrs: Lunch

13:15 hrs: Battle. Attempt to defend the fort against a second American attack. As soon as the battle is over, we can start to pack up.

14:00 hrs: Event closes. All off-site
