FORT at NO. 4
20 - 22 SEPTEMBER

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for the *Return to Number 4: Revolutionary War Encampment Weekend*, Fort at No. 4 in Charlestown, New Hampshire, on Saturday 21 September through Sunday 22 September.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The fort's address is: *267 Springfield Road (NH Route 11), Charlestown, NH*. Directions are attached (page 3).

Friday

10:00 hrs – 20:00 hrs: Camp is open for arrivals. The Crown Forces camp is located behind the fort (enter field to the right of the visitor center).

Saturday

07:30 hrs – 09:30 hrs: Camp is open for arrivals. **Check-in at the Museum Bookstore.**

08:00 hrs: ALL vehicles must be out of camp.

09:00 hrs: Officer meeting at the David Farnsworth House (Building with the bell)

10:00 hrs: Site open to the public

10:00 – 11:45 hrs: Regimental/Company drills

12:00 hrs: Noonning

13:30 hrs: Battle

16:30 hrs: Site closes to the public

Sunday

07:30 hrs – 09:30 hrs: Camp is open for day-trippers. **Check-in at the Museum Bookstore.**

08:00 hrs: ALL vehicles must be out of camp.

09:00 hrs: Officer meeting at the David Farnsworth House (Building with the bell)

10:00 hrs: Site open to the public

10:00 – 11:45 hrs: Regimental/Company drills

12:00 hrs: Noonning

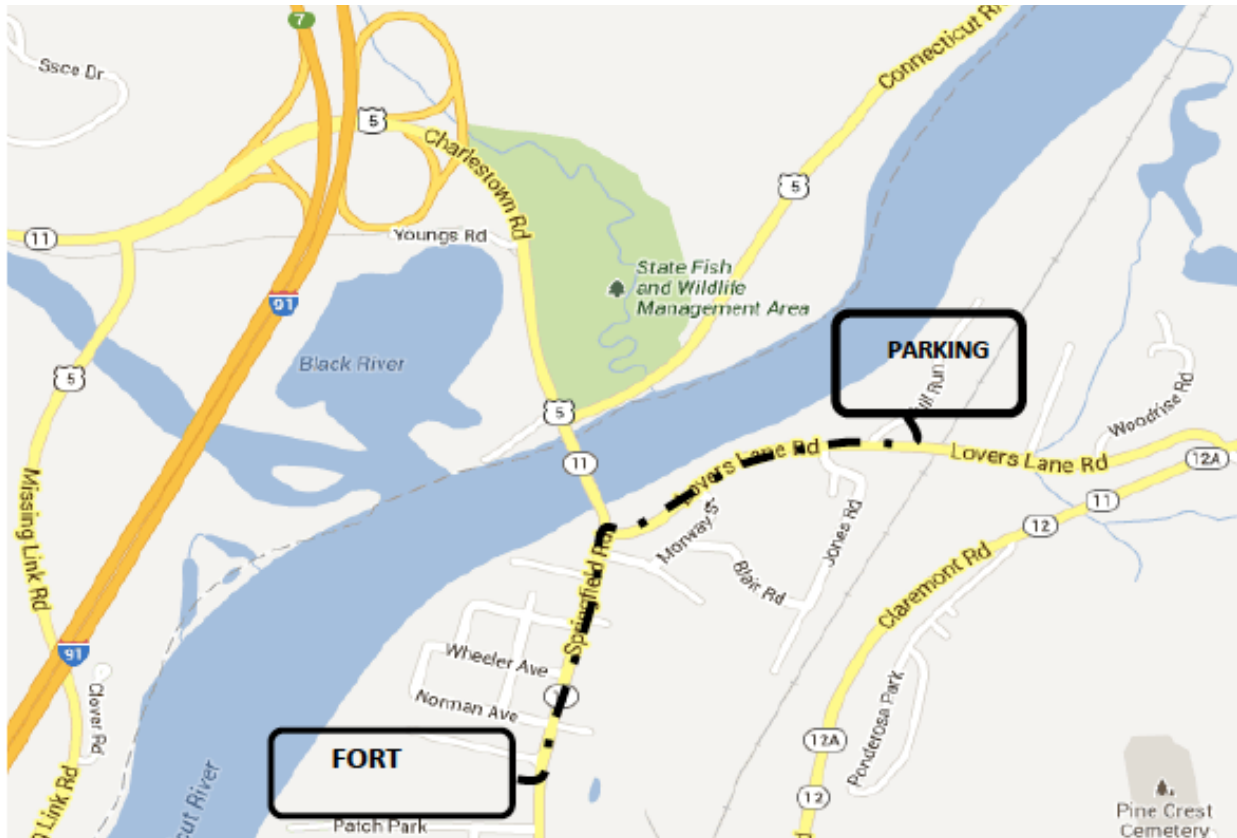
13:30 hrs: Battle

15:00 hrs: Vehicles may enter camp and members may break-down and depart. All members shall assist with the break-down and packing of the Camp Kitchen before packing their personal equipment.

15:30 hrs: Event closes to the public

Please remove your vehicle to the re-enactor parking areas as soon as is practical. Parking for units will be in the upper field starting at the tree line.

In the past, offsite parking has been available at Optical Solutions – about ¾ of a mile north along Lover’s Lane (See parking map). If overflow parking is needed, reenactors should be prepared to park in the designated off-site parking areas.



Special Note: The Regiment has been given the Hasting’s House in the Fort for use as our kitchen and dining hall for the weekend. Thus, we will not need to set-up the kitchen as normal.
