Goals

Short-Term Goal:

Long-Term Objectives

1. Ensuring Consistency

- Encourage a team mentality where contributors can rotate and support one another.

3. Track and Evaluate Social Media Impact

- Conduct polls with current members to assess social media effectiveness and what brough them to join.
- During entrance interviews, ask new recruits which platform influenced their decision to join.
- Solicit feedback from both current members and new recruits on how to improve our online presence.
